## CHARACTERS:

MILDRED, *moderately wealthy owner of the house in which the play takes place* (f, late 50s)

DOROTHY, *companion and housekeeper to Mildred* (f, late 20s)

BUNTING, *the butler, has developed a habit of answering back and a taste for sherry* (m, 60s)

COLONEL CHARLES CRADDOCK, *typical blustering stiff upper lipped British colonel* (m, early 60s)

MARGARET CRADDOCK, *Charles's long-suffering wife* (f, 50s)

PIERRE MARCEAU, *a French art dealer who is not what he seems* (m, early 30s)

ELIZABETH HARTLEY-TRUMPINGTON, *very high society young lady who is not what she seems* (f, mid-20s)

JOAN MAPLE, *amateur sleuth who seems to attract murder wherever she goes* (f, 60s)

INSPECTOR PRATT, *bumbling police inspector* (m, 30s/40s)

CONSTABLE TOMPKINS, *typical young village constable* (m, 20s)
